### SCENARIOS

### ISSUES

- The local recreation centre is having a concert on Saturday night to recognize district fire fighters. Should it proceed?
- The local hospital (name) has difficulty staffing and has requested volunteers. Staff are having difficulty getting to work
- EMS needs staffing assistance
- Should the municipal office stay open?
  - What services should it suspend?
  - What services should it start delivering?
- Several people are quarantined in their homes. Who will deliver food and medicine to them? How?
- People are calling the Municipal office asking for information. Who takes the calls?
- The Health Unit and EMS have asked for an area-wide Emergency Control group to be formed. Who sits on it? Can municipal resources be shared across the district?
- No-one showed up for the day shift at the water treatment plant
- Your Community Emergency Management group has been working for 16 hours. Who steps in for the next shift?
- There is a rumor that alcohol kills the avian flu virus. What does the control group do?
