BOIL WATER ADVISORY ISSUED FOR NOBEL

Medical Officer of Health Dr Jim Chirico has issued a boil water advisory, effective immediately, for all residents of **Nobel** who draw their water from the municipal water system. This order was issued due to total loss of pressure.

A boil water advisory means that people who take their water from the municipal system should not drink the water, use it for cooking, to brush their teeth, or to wash foods, such as fruit and vegetables, which will be consumed without cooking. Water used for consumption or cooking should be brought to a rolling boil and allowed to boil for one full minute before use. Otherwise, the water is safe for bathing.

The Health Unit staff will continue to monitor this situation. The Medical Officer of Health will notify the media when the boil water advisory has been lifted.
