## **BOIL WATER ADVISORY FOR THORNE NOW LIFTED**

Dr. Jim Chirico, Medical Officer of Health, is pleased to announce the lifting of the boil water advisory placed on the Thorne water supply last Thursday, January 27. The lifting is effective immediately.

Two sets of drinking water samples were tested and all results were satisfactory. Turbidity and other parameters are at normal operational levels.

Residential users of the community's water supply are advised to run each of their cold water taps for one minute on first time use to remove any sediment. Large volume users are advised to run cold water taps for two minutes on first time use.
